



Singing Retreat in the Heart of the Conwy Valley

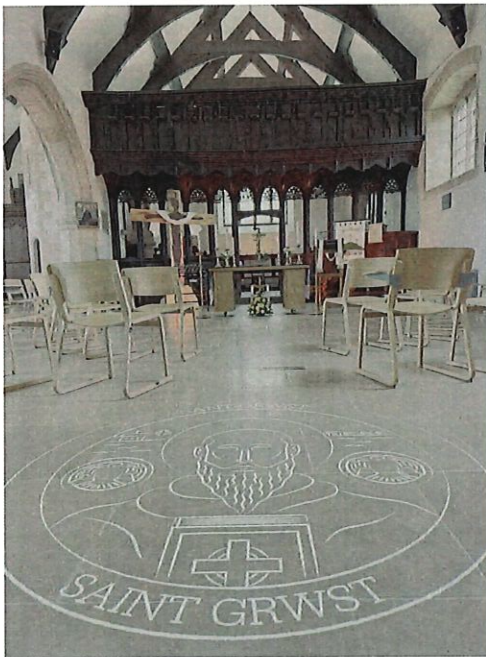
May 27th - 29th



Do you love to sing? Does a relaxed and happy singing retreat with like minded people in the stunning Conwy Valley, North Wales, appeal to you? If so, even if you have little or no experience, you are warmly invited to find your voice and sing some beautiful music, culminating in a gentle sing during a Eucharist service on our final evening.



We will rehearse at St Grwst church in Llanrwst and for the service, drive to St Ffraid's in Glan Conwy. There'll also be time to rest, walk by the river or explore the famous Tu Hwnt i'r Bont tearoom in Llanrwst.



The music will be a selection appropriate for a Eucharist service and all easy to learn. It includes Bob Chilcott's Agnus Dei, Karl Jenkins' Agnus Dei, Sanctus by Lassus and all sorts of interesting melodies and harmonies. The retreat is led by Deborah Catterall for the music and Tad Huw Bryant will lead the Eucharist service.

Deborah has worked with singers for forty years, principally with the National Youth Choir of Great Britain, Chetham's School of Music and currently with vocal ensembles at the Royal Northern College of Music. She also runs Dyffryn Clwyd Singers and Voci Chamber Choir and leads the choral and early music courses

at Higham Hall, Cumbria. She has been a professional soloist for many years. Her next performance will be at this year's Beverley Early Music Festival for the National Centre for Early Music.

The cost of the retreat is £80 each. This will include all materials needed, tea's & coffee's throughout and a soup lunch on each of the 3 days.
